THE FOAM TREATMENT



As a food factory or a retail food outlet gets established and grows, it is inevitable that American Cockroaches, Sewer Flies and Stored Product Insects will take harbourage in the subterranean sewer drains.

If left untreated, the infestation will develop and these pests will appear in the production area when the lights are switched off at the end of the day, to pose health hazards. Treatment often involves flushing and steaming, which is not the most effective treatment. 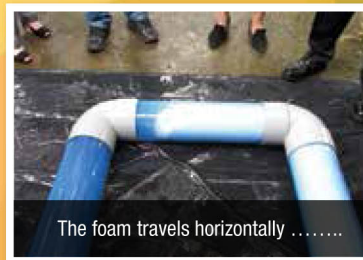


The Foaming Equipment.

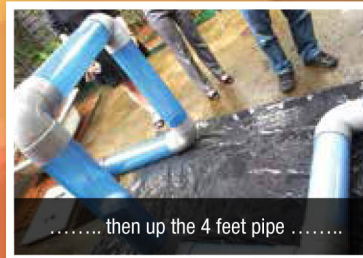
A new insecticidal foaming technique developed by SEMCO in Japan is now available for the treatment of these underground pests. It kills by attacking their nervous system and suffocating them.

This treatment is also very effective against Cockroaches harbouring in the cracks and crevices of rubbish chutes of high-rise condominiums.

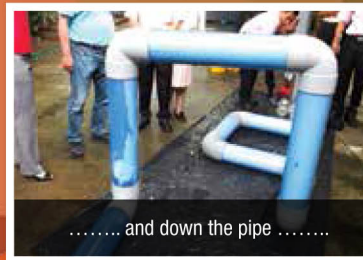
This foam technique is now incorporated into Aardwolf Pestkare's arsenal to serve our Clients' need for a pest-free environment.



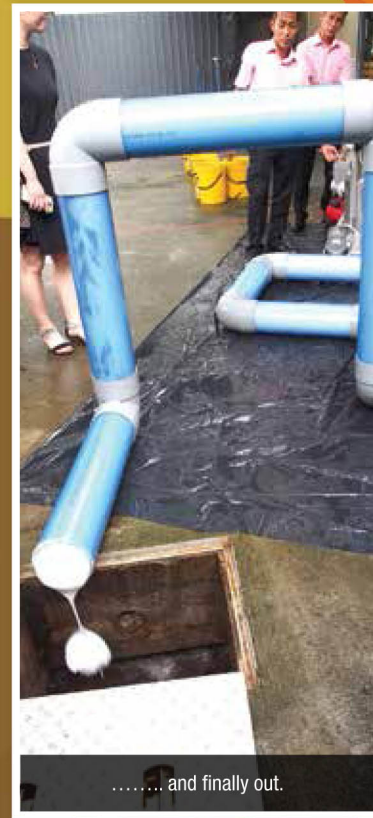
The foam travels horizontally
