Some of them shared their life stories during the pandemic. There was so much fun and laughter throughout the night. We are looking forward to having more gatherings in the future.




















GETTING TO KNOW...



COMMON WOLF SNAKE

The Common wolf snake, *Lycodon capucinus*, is one of the most common snakes in Singapore.

The wolf snake typically grows to 70 cm in length. The pale spots on the back and a white collar around the neck make it distinctive from any other snake.

Common wolf snakes get their name as they have large front teeth resembling the fangs of a wolf. These teeth don't deliver venom but are used to grab and hold onto prey.

The venom-injecting fangs are at the back of the snake's mouth, but the venom is so weak that herpetologists classify Common wolf snakes as non-venomous.

The Common wolf snake is a hunter of geckos and skinks, and because geckos and skinks are often found in buildings and gardens, so are Common wolf snakes too.

What should you do when you encounter a snake in your house? It is important that you never try to kill the snake. It places you at a higher risk of being bitten if you force the snake to defend itself. Keep all family members and pets away from the snake and call Aardwolf Pestkare at 6268 1771.
