HOW CAN YOU AVOID BED BUGS WHILE TRAVELLING?

In recent months, Paris and South Korea have reported a rise in bed bug infestations. The blood suckers are, unfortunately, everywhere, as every other major city in the world has bed bugs.

WHY are bed bugs back now?

The borders reopened after the COVID-19 pandemic and more travel means more opportunity for bed bugs to spread. Although bed bugs have not been shown to transmit disease, their bites can cause allergic reactions, swelling, rashes, and secondary infections from scratching. The sleep loss and emotional distress alone are enough to bring on serious psychological problems.

HOW can you avoid bed bugs when you travel?

When you enter a hotel, immediately check the mattress for reddish-brown blood stains. You can also look for the bed bugs themselves. An unfed adult is about the size of an apple seed. On returning home, luggage should be inspected and kept isolated from the bedroom. All clothing should be laundered on a hot cycle (60°C) to kill all life stages of the bed bugs.

WHAT can you do if you have found bed bugs in your home?

Do not attempt to treat it yourself. As bed bugs have evolved resistance to most of the insecticides, off-the-shelf products have little effect on eliminating them. Bed bugs are difficult to control, and a pest management professional like Aardwolf Pestkare should be consulted.
